(Pastor Brad Thorp) first remember hearing it when I was about five years old on the kitchen couch, while bouncing around with my ADHD. Using Uncle Arthur's Bible Stories Mom patiently told me the story for evening worship.

I remember hearing it in our little Oliver church school with its seven students—while dreaming of building jumps for my bike and how I could terrorize my siblings and cousins. I heard it again from Mrs. Darrell Rick, my first-grade teacher.

I was 13 years old when I was baptized by Pastor Walter Rodgers—making a commitment to someone who I had heard about every day of my life up to that point.

OKAA (OCS), CUC (Burman), Walla Walla College (University), Newbold College in England—each significant points in my journey. Piccadilly Circus! Was I only a "cultural Christian"? Was He real? Or was it only a story of folklore?

In the college classroom studying philosophy and theology the significance of my need of a Savior finally got through to me. My "sinful" nature. Our sinful nature. The world problem of sin needed a solution trillions of times bigger than behavior modification, more education, or improved social conditions—important though these be.

The Story! The story of the creator God who loves me—you! The great controversy between Jesus and Satan. The problem of sin. The need of a Saviour! Forgiveness. His unconditional acceptance of us regardless of our inadequacies. Reconciliation. Restoration. Peaceful sleep while resting in death. God's great big global family—His church. The Second Coming. Hope.

The New Earth. Eternal life and the reality of growing, developing, expanding our knowledge and skills forever and ever and ever. Wow! What a story!

That's why we need to "Tell It Again".

Maybe you are hearing the story for the first time. Or it's easy to get distracted. The weaknesses of our lives trip us up. Pain. Betrayal by someone, or "them", tempts us to disillusionment. We need to get back to the essence of the story! We need to hear it again! We need our "eyes" lifted to see the eternal. The stillness of nature invites His healing. We need to connect again with others who share that hope. We need to "rest" in Jesus.

What About Pets?

SEVENTH-DAY ADVENTIST CHURCH (BRITISH COLUMBIA CONFERENCE) **CAMP MEETING PET POLICIES**

The BC Conference desires its members to enjoy a spiritual, uplifting Camp Meeting experience every year. This Policy will be enforced on the campgrounds for the safety and well-being of all campers. Pet owners should familiarise themselves with this Policy as they will be required to abide by it during their stay in Camp Meeting.

GENERAL PET POLICIES

- 1. All pet owners must sign a Waiver and Indemnity Form releasing the Conference from liability and indemnify the Conference for any damages that their pets may cause.
- 2. Pets need to be registered with Security at the gate **BEFORE** entering the campgrounds.



- 3. Pets are only allowed in RVs, trailers, or cabins. Pets are not allowed in tents or tent trailers.
- 4. No exotic pets are allowed (i.e. ferrets, monkeys, snakes). This policy applies to certain dogs (see specific "Dog Policies" below), cats and caged birds. These will be allowed provided that their owners abide by these policies and


sign the Waiver and Indemnity form.

5. If, in the Conference's sole discretion. it concludes that a pet has caused or is likely to cause damage, harm, or disruption to property or other persons attending Camp Hope, the owner will remove the pet from Camp Hope immediately.

Please be respectful of the Pet Policy and help us by ensuring you are in compliance. We appreciate that animals are wonderful companions and friends. However, for safety, sanitation and occasionally noise reduction, we must enforce this policy. All dogs must be registered to be allowed on the campground. We remind our campers and visitors that pets must be under 30 lbs, on a leash, and only in designated areas of the campus.

Failure to comply with any part of the Pet Policy will result in your being asked to remove your pet from the campground, or personally leave the campground and the loss of the owner's right to reserve the campsite for both the current and following year. Please understand we mean no offence to anyone personally, but we must follow this policy. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation.

2. Each dog must have a collar with an identification tag supplied during registration.



3. Only lapdogs are allowed on the campgrounds.



4. Weight is limited to 13.6 kilos (30 lbs).



5. The Canine Good Neighbour (or equivalent) certification must be provided for all dogs.



6. Dogs must be kept on leash while walking, or in a cage at all times when outside RVs or cabins.



Dogs are not allowed in any public areas:



- Any building
- Washroom facilities
- Meeting places
- Children's Divisions
- Public sidewalks



Owners must pick up after their dogs at all times, in all areas. Plastic bags will be provided at the registration booth.

DAY VISITORS

All General Pet Policies and Dog Policies apply to Day Visitors with dogs.





General Rules, Safety and Security Policies

SEVENTH-DAY ADVENTIST CHURCH (BRITISH COLUMBIA CONFERENCE) CAMP MEETING CAMPER GENERAL RULES, SAFETY AND SECURITY POLICIES


All campers must sign a Waiver and Indemnity form releasing the Conference from liability and indemnifying the Conference for any and all damages resulting from willful disobedience of any and all Camp Meeting Policies on the part of the camper or of any person under the guardianship of the camper.

IMPLEMENTING AUTHORITY

- The Security Team oversees the implementation of the safety and security procedures in the Camp.
- There will be security personnel at the main gate, as well as roving security on the campground, 24 hours a day.

GENERAL RULES

- Check-out time is 12:00 Noon on Sunday following the close of Camp Meeting. Check-out for campers staying on the Youth Hill C-section and D-section is 10:00 AM Sunday.
- The use of generators is allowed between 9:00 AM and 8:00 PM only.



E-Vehicles need to be charged in town. Camp Hope is not set up to accommodate vehicle charging.



SAFETY POLICIES

- Bicycles are permitted on the lower ring road only. Ripsticks, skateboards, scooters, longboards, electric scooters, etc are not permitted anywhere and at anytime during Camp Meeting. If this policy is not complied with, the plaything will be confiscated immediately and can be redeemed by an adult from Security as you are departing the grounds. Failure to comply will result in the the loss of the owner's right to reserve their campsite for both the current and following year.
- A speed limit of 15 kph must be observed on all roads in the Camp (perimeter and all service areas) at all times.
- Curfew will be observed on the Camp. Curfew times are 11:00 PM Sunday to Friday, and 12:00 midnight on Saturdays. Parents or guardians of minors should ensure their children are on their respective campsites by curfew time.

IN AN EMERGENCY

In the event of an emergency, 3 HORN BLASTS will be heard all around the Camp. Please turn vour radio to 90.1 FM for instructions.

BRITISH COLUMBIA CAMP MEETING 2025

- For fire prevention and safety, all roadways and lanes must be kept **CLEAR** at all times to allow access for emergency personnel. DO **NOT PARK ON FIRE LANES.** If a fire alarm sounds, please turn your radio to 90.1 FM for instructions.
- Medical Services personnel are available daily to serve guests as needed. The Medical Building is located between the Lodge and Main Pavilion. See the Camp Meeting booklet for hours of operation.
- Paramedics are available for offhour medical emergencies. See Security Personnel or go to the Lodge Office to request assistance.

FIRE EMERGENCY PROCEDURE

In the event of a fire emergency, you will hear 3 HORN BLASTS. Please turn your radio to 90.1 FM where you will be given instructions. For your safety, please keep roadways and lanes clear at all times for emergency personnel. For fire prevention and safety all roadways and lanes must be kept clear at all times. If a fire alarm sounds **DO NOT** go to the scene of the fire. Assigned personnel will respond.

MEDICAL BUILDING

(Located between Lodge and Main Pavilion)

Paramedics are available for off-hour emergencies. See security personnel or go to the Lodge Office and one will be contacted for you.

OPEN DAILY

9:00 AM - 11:00 AM

2:00 PM - 4:00 PM

In the event of a medical emergency, please contact security who will notify a paramedic.

SECURITY POLICIES

- The front gate will be open between 6:00 AM and 11:00 PM daily. Vehicles can leave after 11:00 PM but will not be allowed to enter until after 6:00 AM. If a camper arrives after 11:00 PM, they must park outside the gate and walk to their campsite.
- Other gates within the Camp (e.g., Youth Hill, Main Pavilion) will be closed during meeting times.
- Day guests attending meetings (not camping) must park in the main field in front of the Lodge.



CAMP FIRES OF ANY KIND (INCLUDING PROPANE) ARE NOT ALLOWED ANYWHERE AT ANY TIME DURING CAMP MEETING.

- Parents/guardians must inform Security Personnel immediately upon arrival if there are any security or restriction concerns for minor campers under their care.
- A parent or guardian must always be present at the site to oversee any minor child (under 19 years of age).

Camp Hope has a Zero Tolerance Policy. Verbal aggression or bullying and harassment of any kind is strictly prohibited. Failure to comply with any part of the General Rules, Safety, and Security Policies will result in the loss of the owner's campsite for both the current and following years.

- Registration for camp sites (full-hook ups for RV/Trailer or non-serviced for tents) for the current Camp Meeting year can be done by email or phone.
- At time of registration, the site must be paid in full. We accept VISA and Master Card only.



- Registration for the current camp meeting starts
 January 1 of the current year.
- Camp Meeting Camper Policy Agreement Form—must be signed and handed over to the Security Personnel at the gate upon arrival.
- Registration of your current site for NEXT YEAR'S Camp Meeting can be pre-paid from January 1 of the current year up until the Tuesday of the current year's Camp Meeting (CM regular office hours only). If you fail to reserve your current site for next year, you risk losing your site after Tuesday of the current Camp Meeting.

Example:

Lilac has a site for 2025. She can book the same site for 2026, starting January 1, 2025 up until the Tuesday of Camp Meeting 2025. (CM regular office hours).

- Registration for a new/different site for NEXT YEAR'S Camp Meeting can be made on or after the Thursday of the current Camp Meeting.
- There is no waiting list for camp site registration.
- Requests for early check-in and late check-out must be approved first by the registration staff. (See Camp Meeting Camper Extension Rate Policy).
- All campers must be on a designated campsite. If you are using an RV/trailer and a tent, you must ensure that your RV/trailer, tent, and vehicle fit completely within the boundaries of your site. If not, you must check with Registration for the nearest available site to pitch an extra tent for other campers in your party.


